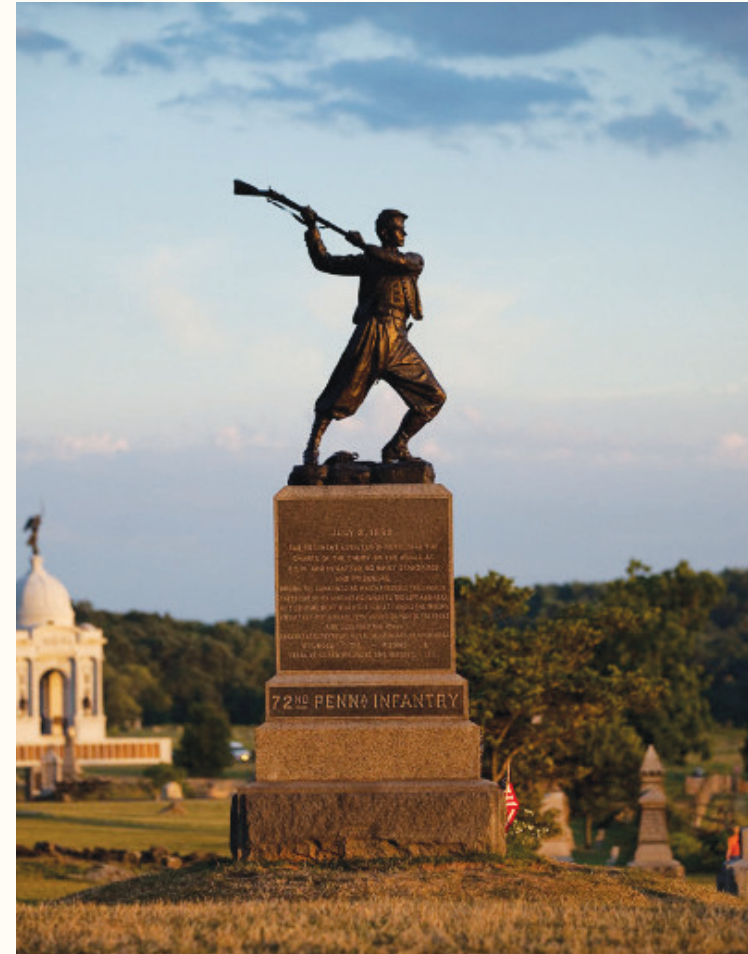

Keynote Speaker



About our Speaker:

Joseph Garrera is Executive Director of the 30,000 square foot Lehigh Valley Heritage Museum and the Lehigh County Historical Society in Allentown, Pennsylvania. He previously served eleven years as president of the Abraham Lincoln

Group of New York, a non-profit historical society in Manhattan. He serves on several prominent Lincoln organizations' Boards of Directors including the Abraham Lincoln Society of Virginia, The Lincoln Forum, and on the esteemed Abraham Lincoln Association in Springfield, Illinois.

Garrera has been a speaker for the United States Historical Society in Richmond, Virginia and at Ford's Theatre National Historic Site in Washington, D.C. In the past 20 years he has presented more than 200 scholarly programs at schools, universities and historical societies. In 2005 he was a guest speaker at the Lincoln Presidential Museum in Springfield, Illinois. In 2009 he was the featured speaker for the National Park Service at the Antietam National Battlefield in Sharpsburg, Maryland for the 200th birthday of Abraham Lincoln.

He earned a Bachelor's degree in American history from Thomas Edison State College and a Master's degree in history with highest honors from East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania.
